Course Overview

The Loyola EMS National Paramedic Review Course is designed for paramedics who want to:

- **Renew their National Registry certification.** The course provides 48-hours of continuing education that covers the Mandatory and Flexible Core Content hours of the National Registry renewal. A total of 72 hours are needed for a National Registry renewal.
- **Challenge the National Registry exam.** The course is a comprehensive **review** of topics included in the National Registry exam. Participants will be able to identify areas of weakness that should be studied prior to taking the exam. (Sign-up for the computer-based written and practical exam is via the National web site.)
- **Obtain CE hours to renew their state license.** The full course is approved for 48 hours of continuing education credit by Loyola EMS System and IDPH. Hour for hour credit will be given for individual days.

* Course participants are responsible for contacting the National Registry directly for renewal or test registration.
