Thank you for your interest in the Loyola University Medical Center Paramedic Program. Our program is designed for individuals seeking to become professional healthcare providers. Acceptance into the program is determined by the combined scores of the written exams and a formal interview.

The next Paramedic class is scheduled to start January 9, 2018 and will run until the middle of December 2018. Classes will be held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Tuition will be \$5000.00, which includes all textbooks, specialty course and lab fees, and uniforms polo and sweatshirt. (Students are responsible for parking and licensing exam fees.)

Enclosed with the paramedic program brochure, you will find an *Application* form which needs to be completed and submitted with ALL required documents listed on the front of the form. The deadline for submission of applications is **noon on Monday, July 10, 2017.**

Pre-admission testing sessions will be held at 9:00 am on Monday, July 31, Tuesday, Aug 1 and Wednesday, Aug 2, 2017 in the EMS classroom. **Please call our office at 708.327.2547 to schedule your testing date after you have submitted your completed application.**

Applicants who have submitted a complete application packet AND meet or exceed the minimum scores on their preadmission exams will be invited to interview with the program coordinator and lead instructor. Prior to final acceptance into the program, qualifying applicants will undergo a fingerprint background check. Any disqualifying convictions as listed in the Health Care Worker Background Check Act [225 ILCS 46] and 77 Ill Adm. Code 955 Section 955.160 will prohibit admission into the program. *
