Thank you for your interest in the Loyola University Medical Center Emergency Medical Technician-Basic (EMT-B) program. This 192-hour course meets and exceeds the requirements of the National Standard Curriculum for EMT education, and will prepare you for taking the certification examination to obtain your EMT-Basic license.

The Loyola EMS System will conduct its next EMT-Basic program from Tuesday **August 3** thru Thursday **December 2, 2010**. Classes will be held every Tuesday and Thursday evening from 5:30 pm to 9:30 pm in the EMS Department classroom at Loyola University Medical Center. Tuition for the course is \$650.00, which includes all textbooks, lab fees, and a clinical uniform shirt. (Students are responsible for parking and licensing exam fees.)

The requirements for admission into the Loyola University Medical Center EMT-Basic program are as follows:

- Minimum of 18 years of age
- Copy of high school diploma or equivalency
- Completed Application form
- Completed Essay form
- Letter of Recommendation outlining your strengths (from someone other than an immediate family member)
- Copy of valid Illinois driver's license
- Copy of current CPR **Healthcare Provider** level card

- Completed Student Health form
- Signed authorization for Criminal Background Investigation
- Copy of personal health insurance card
- \$25.00 application fee (*check or money order made payable to **Loyola EMS System***  
*Visa, Mastercard, Discover, American Express also accepted*)
