Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the Loyola University Medical Center EMT-Paramedic Program. The next EMT-Paramedic class is scheduled to start January 11, 2010 and will run until the middle of December 2010. Classes will be held on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Tuition will be \$4000.00, which includes all textbooks, specialty course and lab fees, and a uniform shirt. (Students are responsible for parking and licensing exam fees.)

Anatomy and physiology will be incorporated into the classroom portion of the course. Therefore, a college level A&P or biology course is no longer a mandatory prerequisite.

Enclosed with the paramedic program brochure, you will find an *Application*, a *Student Health* form, and an *Immunization Verification* form – all which need to be completed and submitted with your application. Also, you will find information on the Loyola Occupational Health Clinic which you may utilize for your required titers/immunizations.

Please use the documentation checklist on the front of the application to ensure that you include **ALL** required materials with your application. The deadline for submission of applications is **4:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 29, 2009.**

Pre-admission testing sessions will be held on Friday, August 7; Monday, August 17 and Thursday, August 27, 2009 in the EMS classroom. **Please call our office at 708.327.2547 to schedule your testing date.**
